Counting in Mugambeh languag

Across Australia there are many different Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander languages. The Yugambeh language was spoken in the land located in south-east Oueensland and north-east New South Wales, now within the Logan City, Gold Coast, Scenic Rim, and Tweed City regions. Ancestors spoke one or more dialects of the Yugambeh Language.
