Aboriginal cultural awareness/education

Jellurgal Aboriginal Cultural Centre is the first of its kind in operation, exclusive to the Gold Coast. It has been authorised and established by the traditional land owners of the Gold Coast and supported by parent organisation, Kalwun Development Corporation. Jellurgal boasts a wide range of activities, governed by its proximity to the Burleigh Headland, and truly was the focal point in Aboriginal lifestyle pre-contact. Jellurgal is the perfect place to reconnect with *Jarra* (Mother Earth).

Local school group package - 3 hours

9.30am Arrival at Jellurgal Aboriginal Cultural Centre

9.45am Amphitheatre presentation of traditional life pre-contact including information on Kombumerri Park Burial Ground and Jebribillum Bora Ring

10am Live Aboriginal dance performance

10.30am Burleigh Mountain Walk (Jellurgal Journey) including:

- Anointment Ceremony: An important ceremony that is conducted by a traditional land owner who will bless us with a safe journey.
- Dreamtime story: The Creation story of the formation of Burleigh Headland.
- Guided walk to Midden (interpretive): Shell middens tell us a lot about Aboriginal activities in the past. The types of shells in a midden can show the type of marine environment that was used, and the time of year when Aboriginal people used it.

11.30am Morning tea on the Jellurgal Aboriginal Cultural Centre verandah (school to provide)

12pm Yarning Circle with Jellurgal staff members: Students and teachers have the opportunity to ask questions covering topics such as Dreamtime, pre-contact, contact and post contact including the stolen generation and Australia's policies surrounding Indigenous Australians.
